This week's poem is *Sea Creatures*. Please read through the poem with your child and discuss it e.g. what is the poem about? Did they enjoy it? Why/why not? Are there any rhyming patterns? Poems can be stuck in homework books or ideally in their red poem books from last year which can be continued if they still have them

As we have been practising doubling in class, please try to continue working on this at home with your children for an extra helping hand. You could use pasta tubes, chocolates or grapes etc. to help them count and work out the answer until they are able to work it out mentally. For example, double 2 grapes = 4 grapes, double 12 pasta tubes = 24.
