Dear Parent/Carer,

We are all very excited about food tasting on Friday with many of the children asking if we will be trying lobster and coconuts! 😊 Percy Parker is doing a super job teaching us our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We have also been practising counting in 10s forwards and backwards from any given number. Our new Pie Corbett story we are working on is *The cat, the bramble and the heron*. The children are fascinated by this story's ending, ask them about it! 😊

This week's poem is *Snapper the Crocodile*. Please read through the poem with your child and discuss it e.g. what is the poem about? Did they enjoy it? Why/why not? Are there any rhyming patterns? Poems can be stuck in homework books or ideally in their red poem books from last year which can be continued if they still have them
