This week's home/school task

This week we have been subtracting. We have been adding on from the smallest number and counting back, using number lines to help if we need them. For homework we would like you to find as many different ways of making the number 20 as you can. You can use mathematical signs, mathematical vocabulary, worded problems etc.

For example:-

$$18 + 2 = 20 \quad 20 = 7 + 13 \quad 100 \text{ subtract } 80 \text{ equals } 20 \quad 20 = 21 - 1$$

Take 35 from 55. How many are left? How many more than 68 is 88?

I had 72 felt pens in my pencil case. I left the tops off 52 of them. How many were still working?

You may decide to do this practically - use pasta shapes, lego etc.
