

'Explore the Shore' with Judith Oakley a Marine Biologist.



On Monday the 5th October 2009 class 6M visited Aberavon beach to find out how the animals and plants living there are adapted to live in their environment.

We conducted a survey to find out what sea creatures are living on the beach at Aberavon. We used a seashore guide to help us identify the Creatures, then recorded the names, amounts and where we found the animals on a survey sheet.
