Mathematics activity:

We have been counting aloud, up to 20 together and counting up to 10 objects, then having a go at writing the number to match the set of objects. At home, using small pasta pieces or small Lego bricks, ask your child to grab a handful and arrange them in a row. Ask him/her to count them and have a go at writing the number. (You will need to write numbers to 10 on a piece of paper) They could write the numbers they have made in their homework book.

Useful information!

Many of you have asked about P.E days and book bags etc.

We hope that the following points will help with some of your queries:

Book Bags: Please send them in on a Monday and we'll return them on a Friday with homework, books etc.

Snack money and dinner money: paid on Monday morning and in labelled envelopes please.

Coats: We like the children to wear a coat every day as we go outside in all weathers. (It is essential that all clothing is clearly labelled so that your child comes home with all their clothing at the end of the day.

Water bottles: We encourage the children to drink water throughout the day to stay hydrated, so please could you provide a water bottle which can be kept in the classroom (this is separate from the drink in their packed lunch box).

Reading books: We like books to be returned on a Monday and they will be changed on Wednesday and Friday (as appropriate).

P.E. days: Rec. Littlejohns - Friday, Rec. Knight Tuesday.

Please could children come to school dressed in navy or black shorts and a white, yellow or pale blue tee shirt, worn underneath a school tracksuit, wearing trainers with Velcro fastenings.

It would help us greatly if you would encourage your child to dress him/herself at home so that they can dress and undress independently at school.
