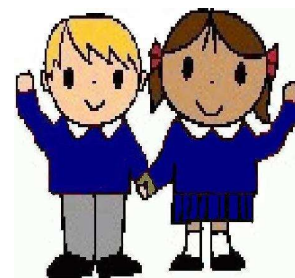


Home Activities



Dear Parent / Guardian,

This week we have been practising number bonds to 10. You could continue practising these at home by saying any number below 10 and your child telling you the bond to make 10. E.G. you say 4 your child says 6. All the children have completed an innovation of the introduction of the story *Monkey See - Monkey Do*. The children have changed the animal, the main character and what is being sold. The children have found it both enjoyable and challenging. Hannah Lewis told her friends it was the hardest work she had ever done!! 😊

We have been learning the 'y' sound at the end of the word which is usually 'ee'. The main way of spelling the 'ee' sound is 'ee', but when but when it is at the end of a multi-syllabic word it is usually written as a 'y'.

Continue to practise all the following tricky words go, do, to, do, are, all, you and your, come, some, said, here, there and they.

Ask your child to tell you their version of the introduction of the Pie Corbett story '*Monkey See Monkey Do*'

Your task this week is to sit or stand still in your garden on the weekend and think about what you can smell, hear and see. You can record this in words or pictures in your homework books. Also, with an adult touch two natural objects and record how they feel. Finally, drink some fresh water and any juice and record their taste.

For maths all children have been given a number bond game to play with an adult or older brother or sister. Enjoy!!! 😊
