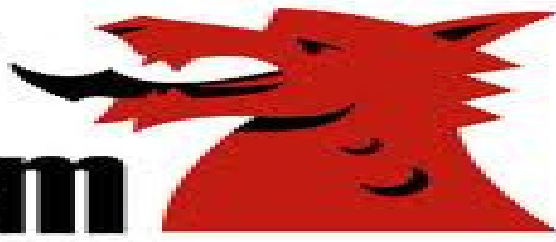


Show Racism the RED Card

Entries need to be completed by Monday 23rd January and submitted to your class teacher. Don't forget to put your name and year group on your entry - good luck.



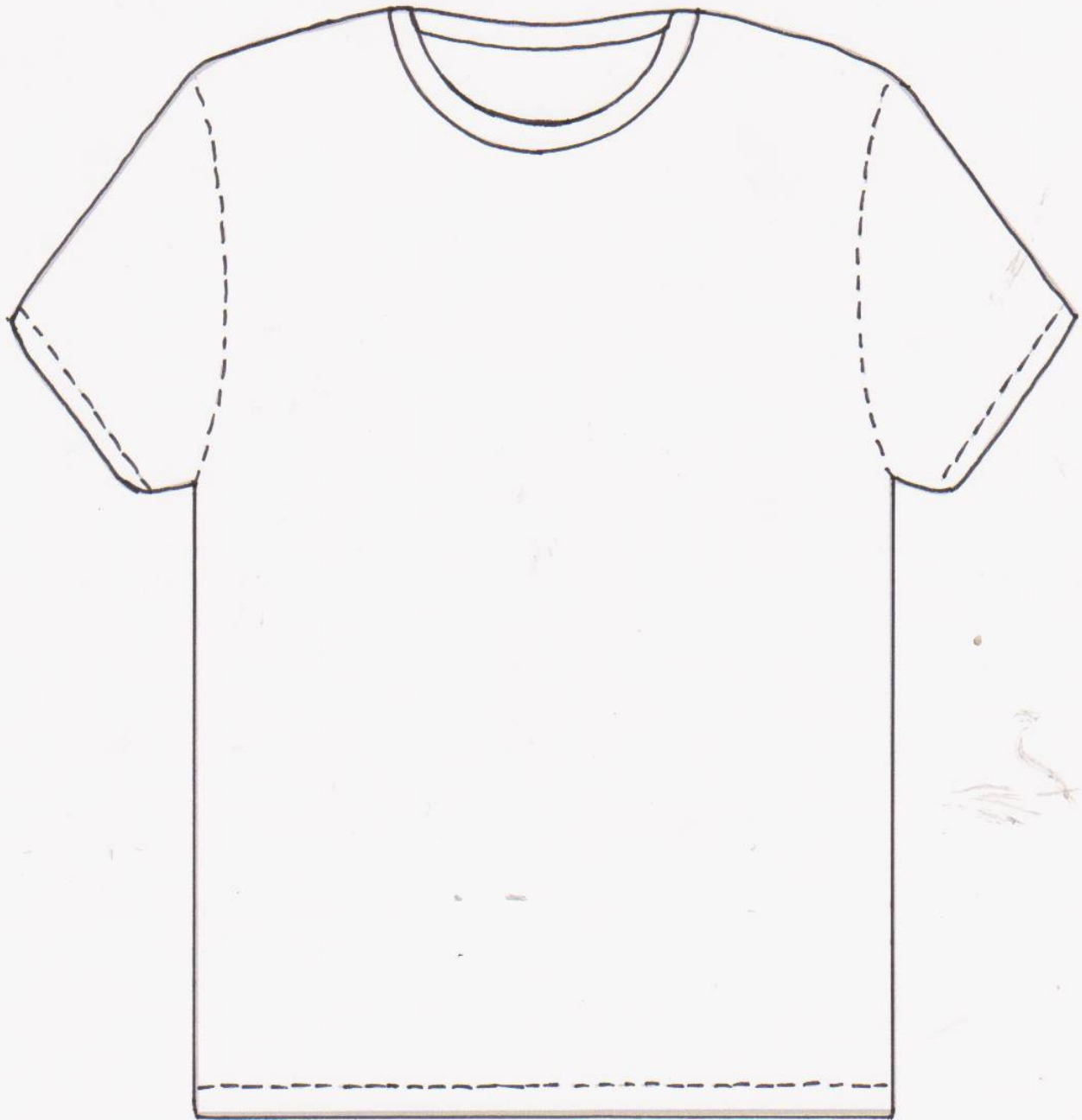
