

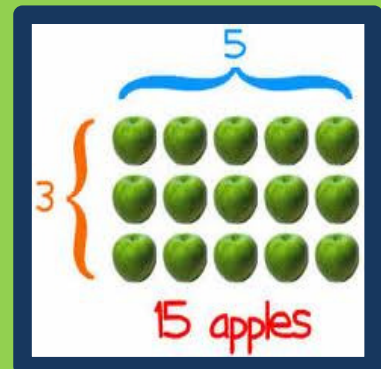
# Year 5/6 Homework
