

# Reception Home Activities



We have had another enjoyable week in Reception.



This week, the children have been adding 2 and 3 to a number up to 10.

Home Activity ( materials needed – ten small biscuits, a coin, paper, pencil)

This is a fun activity which we are sure the children will enjoy. On a large sheet of paper, draw a snake with ten segments and number each one 1 to 10. Place two biscuits on numbers 1 and 2. Toss the coin. If it lands on heads, add one more biscuit, if it lands on tails, add two more biscuits. Encourage your child to say how many there will be altogether before adding them to the line.

In class, the children have been finding out about floating and sinking. Before they placed the objects in the water, they had to predict whether they thought the object would sink or float. At home, have fun investigating whether or not different objects will float or sink. You can use the kitchen sink or have fun in the bath.
