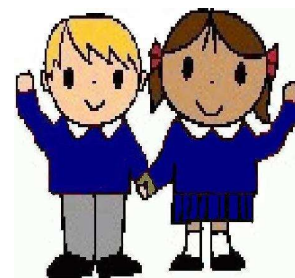


Home Activities




Dear Parent / Guardian,
