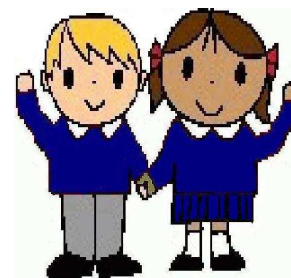


Home Activities



Dear Parent / Guardian,

This week we have been learning an alphabet name song and practising all the single letter sounds. The children have been investigating a burglary and are in the process of finger printing and interviewing staff, including Mrs Dobson, who is currently our prime suspect. We are looking forward to PC Puckett visiting, as he is going to talk to us about his duties as a Policeman in the event of a burglary. We will make comparisons to our investigation.

Our tricky words next week which we will be learning to spell from memory are 'come' and 'some', so please practise them each day, and also don't forget to revise the previous tricky words- all, are, I, the, he, she, me, we, be, was, to and do.

Write 4 sentences about your weekend, using as many of the tricky words as you can. Remember to use finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. Some children may need to write under your writing.

In numeracy, we have been learning about measures. Make a 10cm strip using a piece of card. Decorate it with your name. Choose something to measure. Draw a picture of it. How many strips long is it? How many strips wide is it? You could choose a few more objects to measure.

We are in the process of organising parts for our Christmas concert 'Ned's Christmas Discovery'. We will display parts and costumes, as soon as they have been allocated.

Keep using the Bug Club program which will be updated regularly. If you have read your books, don't forget you can revisit them as many times as you want.
