This week in nursery we have heard the story of The Billy Goats Gruff. We have set up a tuff spot in class with all of the things we need to role-play the story. We've had great fun building bridges that the troll can fit underneath without bumping his head. We've also enjoyed word-building using some of the sounds we've learnt so far. We've made 'trip' and 'trap'! In the 'Let's Find Out' area, we've had opportunities to investigate materials to see which float and which sink. We then sorted them into groups and recorded what we found out by drawing simple pictures to represent the objects. We've enjoyed adding by using flowers in a flower shop.

Our 'Number Zoo' number is Snappy Six. A very snappy crocodile! Ask your child to tell you all about her! You could encourage your child to recognise/name/write some of the numbers we've learnt so far! Remind them to start at Snappy Six's tail, make a curvy line around her back legs, and quickly go back up to her tail before she snaps!

At home this weekend, during bath-time, let your child investigate different objects that float and sink. Help him/her to sort the objects into groups. Have fun finding the ones that sink!
