You may like to:

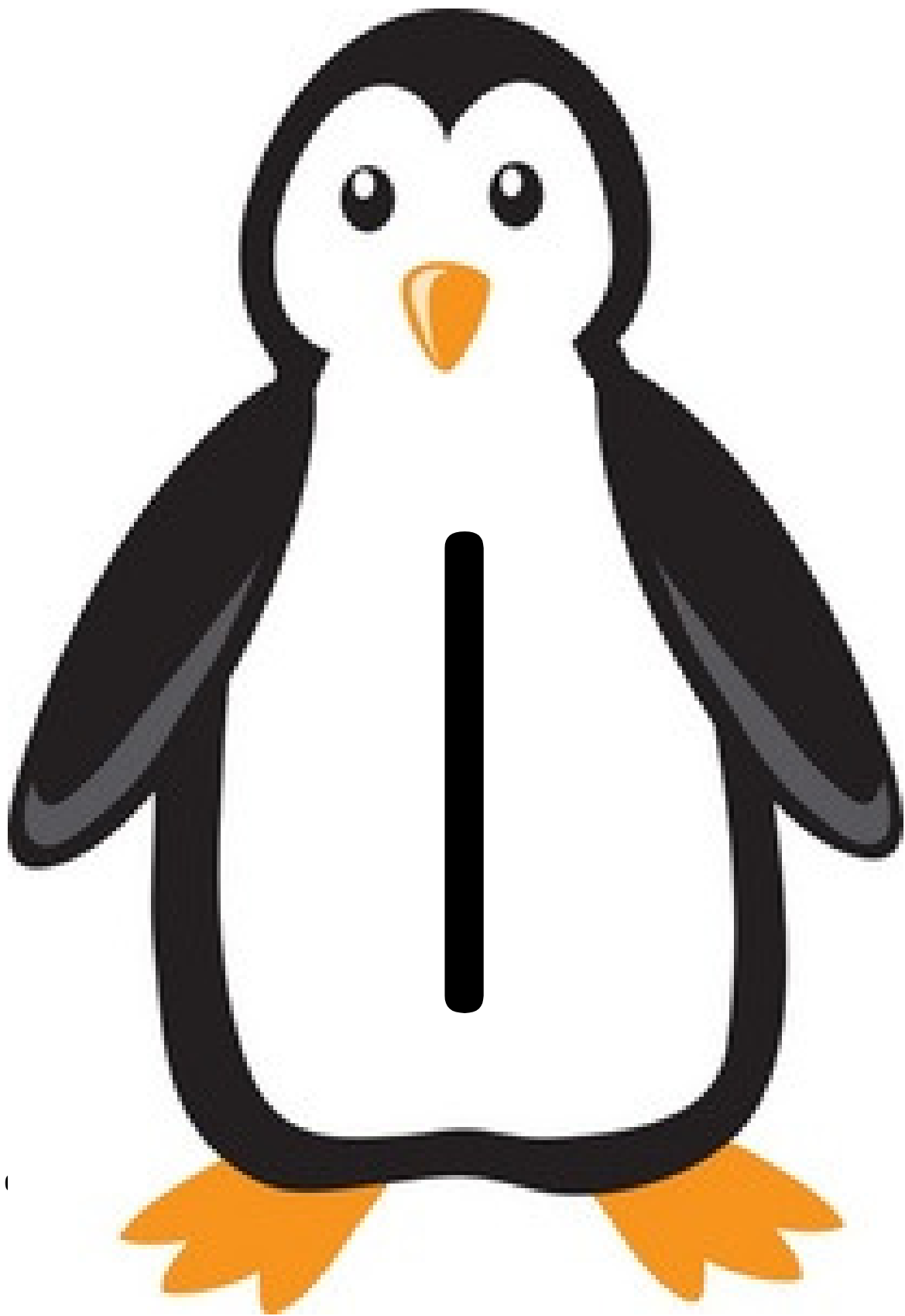
- ✓ Spot as many 1's as you can around the home/town.
