You may like to:

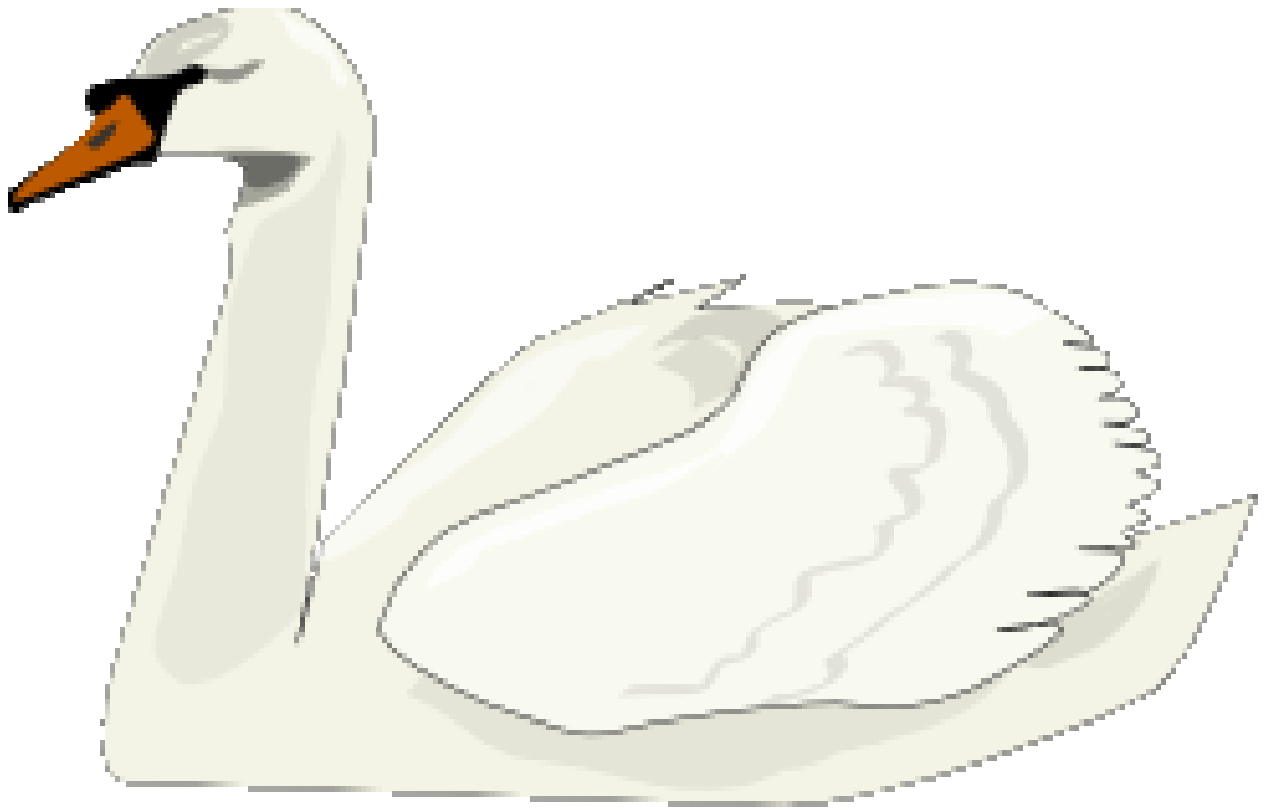
- ✓ Look at the moon with your child. Talk about its shape. What would an adventure to the moon be like?
